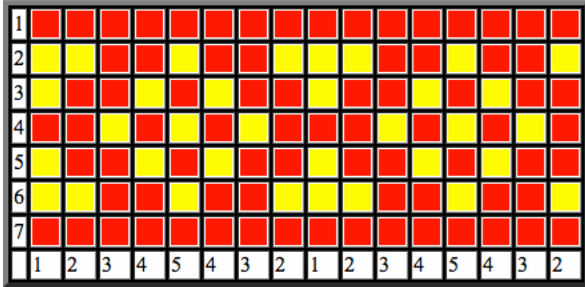


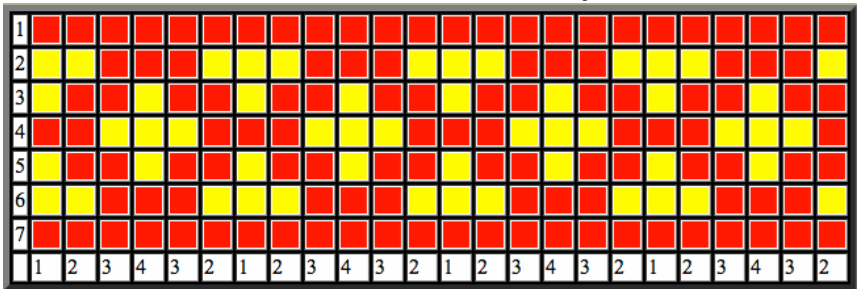

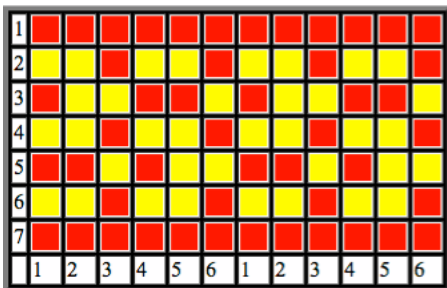


Graves 41, 51, 64, Pattern 3 6th century or a little later



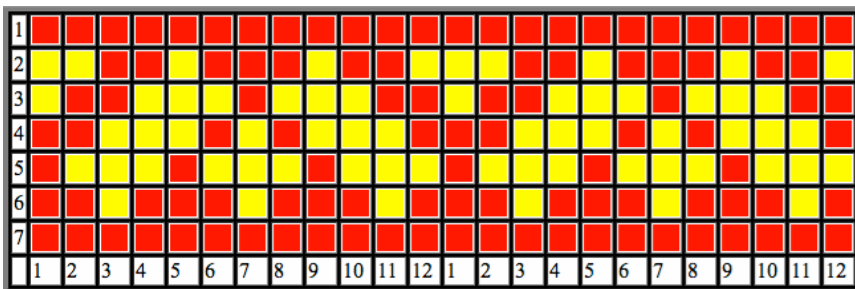

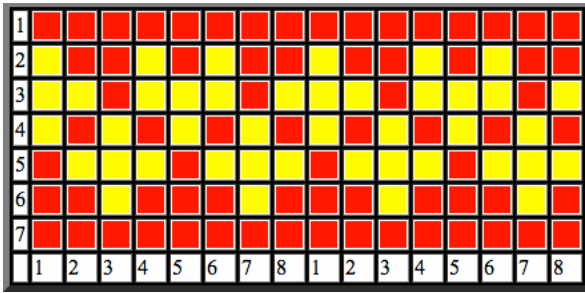

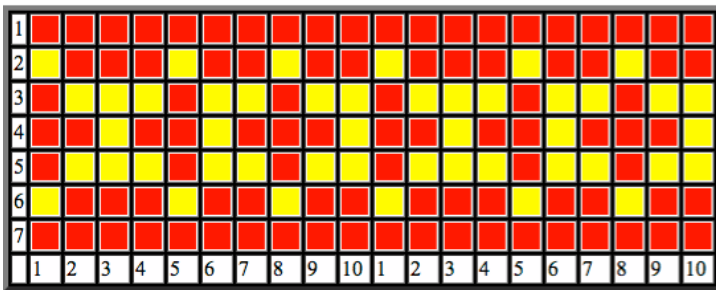

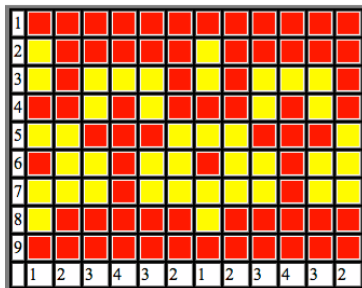


Grave 21 6th century or a little later

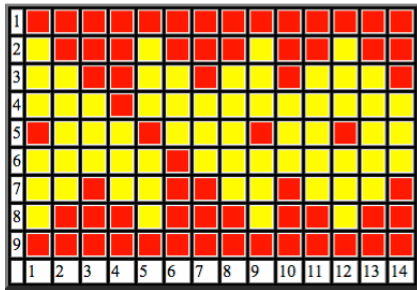

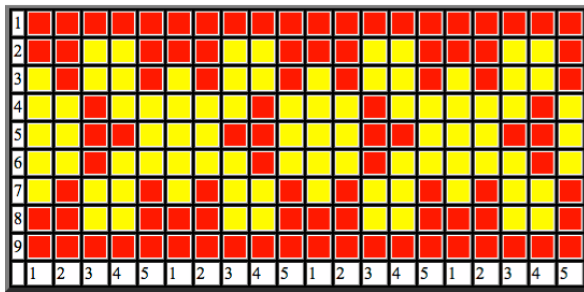

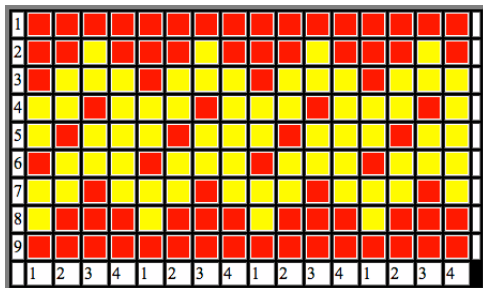

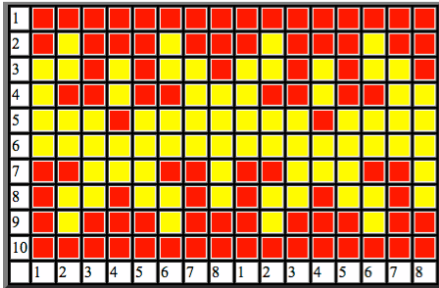

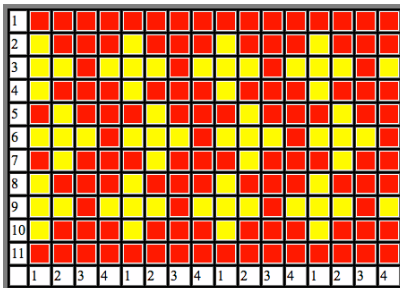

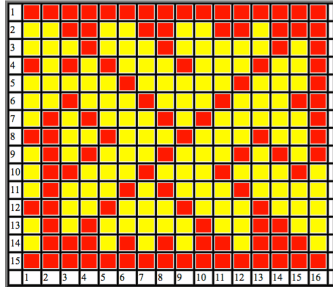

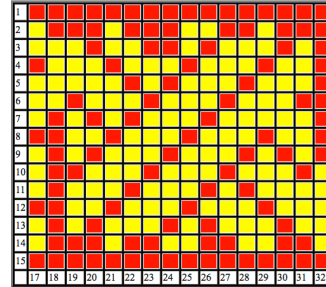

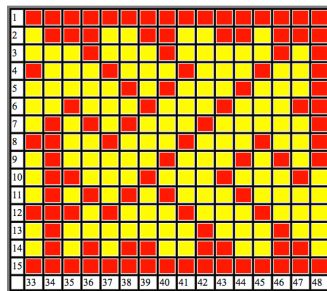
Chessel Down, Shalfleet, Isle of Wight, mid 6th century



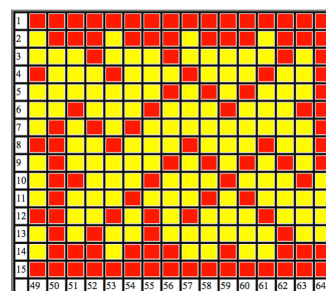

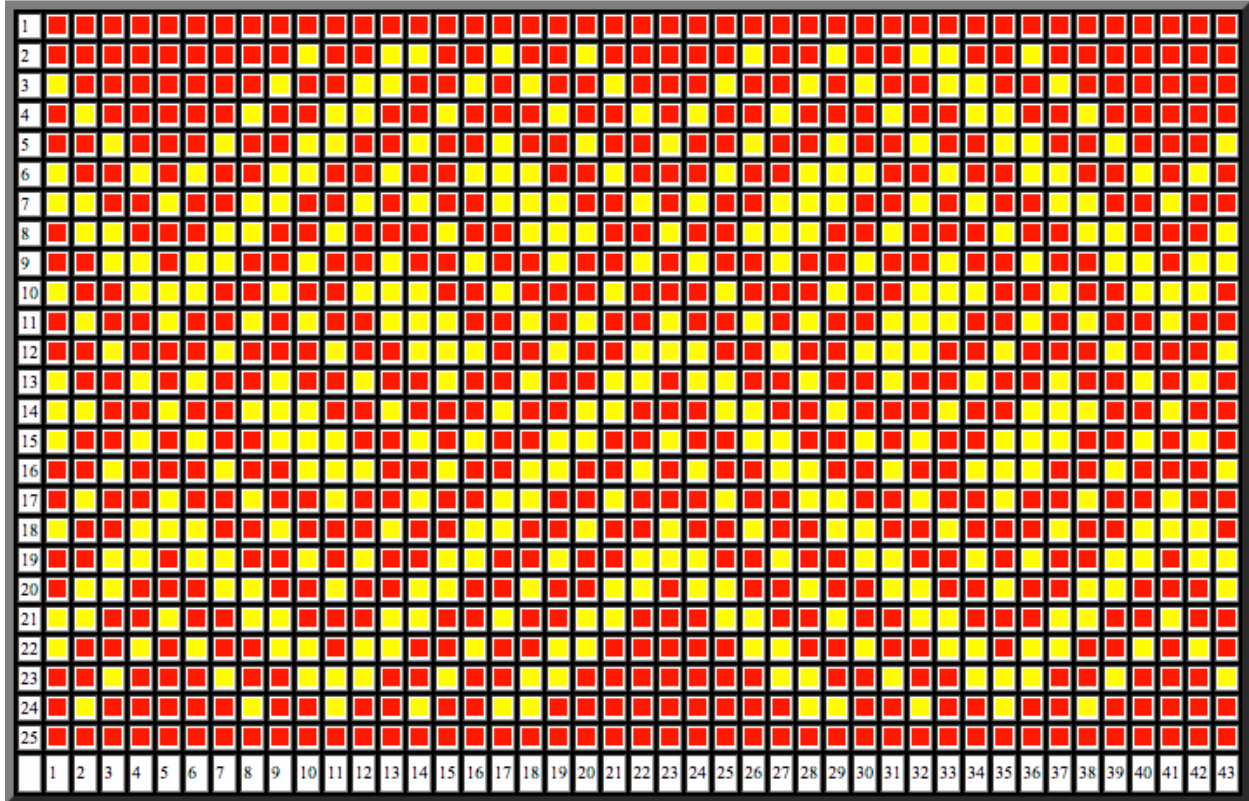
